What is the difference between 7 and 13-pin electric kits?

7-pin electric kits are used in normal light trailers, where constant power and trailer battery charging is not available. This electric kit doesn't support reverse light in caravan.

13-pin electric kits are necessary in most cases for caravans and horse trailers.

What is the difference between universal and vehicle-specific/genuine electric kits?

Universal electric kit can be fitted in many types of vehicles and is cheaper alternative for genuine electrical kit. This kit has no plugs for specific car and doesn't work with on-board computer. In many cars vehicle-specific electrics could be fitted by plugging in, some work with CAN-BUS-compatible electrics. In this case, wires length and fitting instructions are prepared for the actual car.

What is the indicator failure warning?

Indicator failure warning is a feature of the towbar's electric kit, that is obligatory in Germany, Austria, Switzerland, and United Kingdom. It monitors for trailer's indicators bulb damage and gives acoustic, or visual warning.
